Since universal fit forklift buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the equipment and are less vulnerable to damage. These buckets are also 50 percent deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional room makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like for example backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.
